I had the fortunate opportunity to attend a very important board meeting at the Texas Masonic Retirement Center in February. Exciting events are happening as tremendous strides are being made in preparation for a new building, review of investments, oil and gas discussions, etc. The board of directors for the TMRC, and **Kirby Rudisill** are doing a fantastic job, as they continue to always put the residents first in all their doings. Texas York Rite is very fortunate. If you have not had a chance to visit our Texas Masonic Retirement Center (owned by the Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Texas), I really would encourage you to do so.

In consulting with **Gary Alexander**, we discussed the possibility of conferring the Commandery Orders upon him next month. I would like to consider conferring the Orders upon him on Monday, March 24th for the Illustrious Order of the Red Cross, and Order of Malta, and Monday, April 28th for the Order of the Temple. I know we would like to practice the Order of the Temple with the current officer lineup to prepare for the inspection. Actually conferring an order upon a live candidate would be very meaningful.
