

United States York Rite News

This month we will focus on the United Grand Imperial Council of the Red Cross of Constantine and Appendant Orders, United States of America, Mexico and The Phillippines.

As reported last month, Arlington Commandery is extremely fortunate to have 2 newly made members of St Timothy Conclave, of the Order of the Red Cross of Constantine. Jeff Bennett and Rick Montey.

The Red Cross of Constantine is officially *The Masonic and Military Order of the Red Cross of Constantine and the Orders of the Holy Sepulchre and St. John the Evangelist*, the latter two of which are called the Appendant Orders. There are also two chair degrees conferred on the Viceroy and Sovereign of a Conclave, and two honorary orders: Knight Commander of Constantine and Knight Grand Cross. The governing body of the Order for the United States of America, the Republic of Mexico and the Republic of the Philippines and their territories is styled The United Grand Imperial Council of Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine and Appendant Orders for the United States of America, Mexico and the Philippines.

The purpose of the Constantinian Orders are to commemorate the first elevation of Christianity from the position of a despised and proscribed heresy to that of a legally recognized and honored religion, to cultivate the social virtues, appeal to the intellectual and moral qualities, preserve as far as possible the customs of the fraternity and bring about good fellowship and understanding between all branches of Masonry.

Knights Companions of the Order meet in Conclaves of the Red Cross of Constantine and a member must be a Royal Arch Mason in good standing and subscribe to a belief in the Christian religion as revealed in the New Testament. Membership is by invitation and each Conclave has a prescribed membership limit.

The <u>Byzantium</u> is the official publication of the United Grand Imperial Council of the Red Cross of Constantine and Appendant Orders for the United States of America, Mexico and the Philippines. It is published twice yearly, in the spring and in the early autumn. Its purpose is to inform the members of the Order on the activities of the United Grand Imperial Council at its Annual Assembly held each June, and on the activities of the several regions, divisions and Conclaves.

Every York Rite Mason should be able to give clear and concise responses to these three questions in the time that it takes an elevator to move 3-5 floors. Your ability to give these responses has direct impact upon whether prospective members decide to petition.

What is York Rite Masonry?

The York Rite of Freemasonry is open to any **Master Mason** in good standing. The York Rite is comprised of three bodies, each with its own line of officers and ritual, and charitable activity. These are the **chapter of Royal Arch Masons**, **council of Royal and Select Masters**, and **commandery of Knights Templar**. Unlike the **blue lodge**, candidates in the York Rite do not need to complete any proficiency examination of memory work. And like in the **blue lodge**, but unlike in the **Scottish Rite**, the method of presentation we use in our degrees involves active participation from the candidates, which adds meaning and impact for everyone.

What do we do in our **Chapter** and Council that will be Attractive to a Non-Member?

First, we have fun. It is great to get together with Masons from different **blue lodges** to share ideas, hear about activities, and support each other. Second, we are dedicated to sharing more Masonic light with our candidates by participating in our degrees and giving them a quality experience, along with our "short talk" programs and discussions at our meetings. Third, many of our activities involve our families, and the York Rite provides an opportunity for everyone to meet and spend time with good people.

What are the Benefits of Joining the York Rite?

York Rite Masons are better Masons because of the two main benefits of joining. First, you will receive valuable instruction and lessons that complete many of the stories and lessons that you learned in your blue lodge degrees. These include the completion of King Solomon's temple, the recovery of the long lost Master Mason's Word, and many others that you will enjoy learning. Second, you may enjoy fellowship with Masons from several different lodges in your area, thus extending your Masonic connections, and experiencing the meaning of true universal brotherhood.
