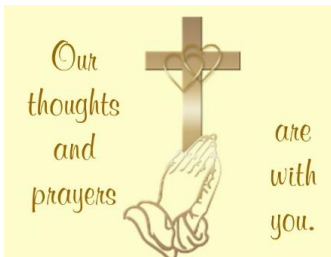

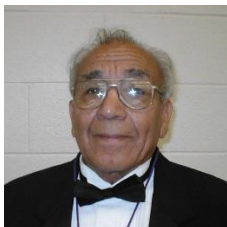
## York Rite School of Instruction
