





Billie Eugene Davis was born July 18, 1928 in Huckabee, Texas. He worked for his father doing general farming work in Stephenville Texas, as well as other jobs as a youth. He is a proud Aggie. Billie was very active in all sports. He earned a B.S. degree in Civil Engineering in June, 1949.



He joined the Army in 1950. He received an honorable discharge from the Armed Forces of the United States of America on October 17, 1960. 
