


RESOLUTION NO. 3

Referred to the Committee on Purposes & Policies* and Jurisprudence

To the Most Excellent Grand Royal Arch Chapter of Texas:

WHEREAS there is a need for Royal Arch Masonry to reach beyond the walls of Chapter Tabernacles to demonstrate Masonic values to those who have no knowledge of those values by drawing back the 3 "veil of secrecy" covering Masonic values and to share those values in ways that exemplify Masonry in a positive way; and

And WHEREAS such outreach must be a long term and continuing effort requiring planning, coordination and leadership from a dedicated group; and And WHEREAS such an outreach effort may provide opportunities for collaboration between this Grand Royal Arch Chapter and other Masonic and affiliated bodies in an effort to form and foster positive relationships with non-Masonic organizations in a way that would require a permanent and continuing point of contact and coordination; and

And WHEREAS the Grand Royal Arch Chapter is uniquely positioned to lead this outreach effort;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a Committee on Masonic Outreach be created with the following duties:

- 1. Create and foster positive relationships with non-Masonic organizations, including jointly sponsored activities, visitations, and communications to demonstrate Masonic values to the non-Masonic world;
- 2. Enhance the image of York Rite Masonry, in particular, and Masonry in general, beyond Masonic and affiliated organizations and members through such activities as may be appropriate means to demonstrate Masonic values;
- 3. Coordinate joint activities with non-Masonic organizations within this Grand Jurisdiction, as may be appropriate;
- 4. Lead collaborative efforts of Masonic and affiliated organizations in outreach initiatives through joint planning and execution of activities, visitations, and communications as may be appropriate;
- 5. Seek opportunities to enhance relationships with non-Masonic organizations and individuals through sharing of Masonic values; and 4
- 6. With the elected Grand Officers of this Grand Royal Arch Chapter, annually create and update a multi-year program to encompass these activities, publish that plan for use with Masonic and affiliated bodies, and coordinate the execution of that plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Committee on Masonic Outreach be made up of five members, each serving for a term of five years; the first five of which shall be assigned terms of five, four, three, two, and one year each, one of whom will be designated a Chairman of the Committee, to be appointed by the Grand High Priest; with one new member and the Chairman of the Committee being appointed by the Grand High Priest each year thereafter; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Committee on Masonic Outreach report annually to this Grand Royal Arch Chapter and semiannually to the Grand Trustees.
