W. L. "Bill" Blanks

William Lee "Bill" Blanks was born at San Angelo, Texas



on August 6, 1925, the son of William Henry and Emma Lee Banks. He grew up in West Texas where his father was a rancher. He graduated from Iraan High School in Iraan, Texas, where he was active in sports and 4-H Clubs. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1943 to 1946 in the South Pacific. On March 20, 1948 he married Ann Reed of Granbury, Texas. They reside at 5112 South Drive in Fort Worth. They are active members of Central Christian

Church in Fort Worth, where he serves as Elder Emeritus. In 1962 he founded the firm of Blanks Welding Supply and continued as an active partner until his retirement in 1997.

He was raised a Master Mason in Granbury Lodge No. 392 on January 21, 1952. He affiliated with Southside Lodge No. 1114, Fort Worth, on June 10, 1974 where he served as Master in 1980-81. In 1982, he served as Right Worshipful District Deputy Grand Master of Masonic District No. 64-D of the Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of Texas A.F. & A.M. 1980-1981. He received the Golden Trowel Award in 1994.

He was exalted as Royal Arch Mason in Polytechnic Chapter No. 404 on October 24, 1959. He affiliated with Southside Chapter No. 378 on March 27, 1974, where he served as High Priest in 1976-1977. In 2000 he served District Deputy Grand High Priest. He is a recipient of the cornerstone Award.

He was greeted a Royal and Select Master in Polytechnic Council No. 336 on November 5, 1959. He affiliated with Southside Council no. 315 on March 27, 1974 served as Thrice Illustrious Master in 1976-1977. In 1996 he served as District Deputy Grand Master. He received the Cryptic Triangle Award in May, 2000. He was knighted in Southside Commandery No. 83 on September17, 1960. He served as Commander in 1971, and served several years as Instructor. He served on the District 6 Templar Instruction Committee from 1973 until 1977. He has been a Life Member of the Knights Templar Eve Foundation since 1968. He is a dual member of Worth Commandery No. 19. He served as Right Eminent Grand Commander of the Grand Commandery Knights Templar of Texas in 1983-1984. He received

the Knight Commander of the Temple Award in 1997 from the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar and the Excalibur Award from Southside Commandery No. 83 in 1997.

Brother Blanks received his Scottish Rite Degrees in Dallas on April 24, 1960, and transferred to the Fort Worth Consistory as a Charter Member on November 26, 1973. He was honored in 1977 by becoming a Knight Commander Court of Honor of the Fort Worth Scottish Rite Bodies. In 1983 he was coroneted 33rd Degree Inspector General Honorary.

He is a member of Moslah Temple Shrine.

He served as Governor of Trinity York College No. 154 in 1997. He received the Order of the Purple Cross in 1994 and the Gold Honor Award.

In 1998 he served as Sovereign of St. Timothy Conclave, Red Cross of Constantine.

In 1990 he served as Preceptor of Our Redeemer Tabernacle No. IX, Holy Royal Arch Knights Templar Priests.

He is a member of the Order of High Priesthood, Super Excellent Master's Degree, Order of Silver Trowel, Knights of the York Cross of Honor, Royal Order of Scotland, Honorary Legion of Honor, Order of DeMolay, Worth Shamrock Council No. 54, Robert Bruce Brannon Council No. 270, Honorary member of Gen. William J. Worth Chapter No. 463, National Sojourners, Inc. and Cowpens Camp Heroes of '76. Brother Blanks is a member of South Fort Worth Chapter 835, Order of the Eastern Star and served as Worth Patron in 1980-81, 1981-82, 1985-86, 1988-89, 1991-92, 1993-94 and 1999-2000.
